There is also an option for adding up to three representatives to the individual member list.

Through MnMN, organizations, institutions, and congregations find new, and strengthen existing, relationships among many faith traditions; support the network's **communication efforts**, which also provide a platform for promoting events; and help the network's **convening efforts**, which offer leadership training, learning, and opportunities for continued relationship building.
